FIT

UNISEX NWU SHIRT

Chest
Pinch 4 to 6 inches total ease at underarms.

Center front should overlap without gaping.

Shoulders
Seams may fall off shoulders.

Length
Shirt hem should extend to the bottom of the crotch but not longer than middle of trouser cargo flap.

Sleeve Length
Length of sleeve should cover wrist bone, but not extend further than the first knuckle at the base of the thumb.

Neckline Closure
Comfortable when buttoned for breathless conditions.

Go to Enhanced size if

- Back wrinkles over hip line
- Center front gaps open




Seat

Step 1 - Measure Waist	UNISEX NWU TROUSERS
Step 2 - Measure Inseam	Waist Four fingers to fit comfortably inside waistband and elastic should not be fully extended
	Seat Amount of ease should allow squatting and bending without binding.
	If pinch is 2 to 4 inches total ease at bottom of pockets, stay in Basic size
	If pinch is less than 2 inches total ease at bottom of pockets, try Enhanced size
	Length Allow sufficient length to touch deck without boot and to properly blouse trousers

<p>Step 1 - Measure circumference of head approximately 1 inch above ears with tape parallel to deck. Measure woman's head with correct hair placement.</p>	<p>UNISEX NWJ CAP Cap should fit snugly centered on head and not rest on ears. The visor should be just above eye level and parallel to deck.</p>







Length
Allow sufficient length to touch deck without foot and to properly blouse trousers.

The belt size is the finished length (+/- 1/2"). To shorten a belt, individuals can use a hot knife and cut to the desired length.

To prevent the belts from shrinking, please use the recommended laundering - hand wash in warm water with mild detergent and hang or lay flat to dry. Do not bleach or dry clean.
