COMMANDER SARAH J. GEOFFRION Executive Officer Training Center Yorktown

CDR Sarah Geoffrion assumed the duties as Training Center Yorktown's Executive Officer in April 2024, previously having served as the Training Center's Prevention Training Branch Chief since June 2023.

Upon graduating from United States Coast Guard Officer Candidate School in 2003, Commander Geoffrion served as the Marine Events Branch Chief and as an apprentice Marine Inspector at CG Activities New York. In her following tour at Sector San Juan, PR in 2007, she served as the Domestic Vessel Inspection Branch Chief, Assistant Chief of Inspections and Senior Investigating Officer. As the Supervisor of Marine Safety Detachment Kenai, AK in 2010, she oversaw the unit's move and became a plankowner of Marine Safety Detachment Homer, AK. She qualified as an Instructor at Training Center Yorktown in 2013 and shortly thereafter assumed the School Chief position for the Marine Inspection and Investigation schoolhouse.
